

SELECTMEN'S MEETING – November 21, 2011

Correspondence was read and acted upon.

The Sugar Hill Action Committee will meet at the Crapo Building on December 11, 2011 at 11:00 AM.

CHIEF WENTWORTH, met with the Select board to discuss schedules. In addition the Chief notified the board that he would like to start some community information sessions. The board was in favor of the Chief getting information out to the community.

The Selectmen discussed legal information from Attorney Fulton.

The Selectmen received the Sugar Hill Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan as submitted by Chief Clark. A public hearing will be held to accept the plan.

The Road Agent notified the board that the two 1-Ton trucks are having the frames repaired. Littleton Chevrolet is trying to get the warranty to cover these repairs. Mr. Hucksoll completed the brake repair on the Building & Grounds truck.

MR. STRASSER will get the setbacks for a garage that has been demolished on the Richard Fowler property.

The board discussed the Veteran's Committee and would like to ask the previous members if they would be interested in serving on the committee again.

The Selectmen appointed Ron Cole and Tim Burger to the Sugar Hill Conservation Commission. They will be sworn in at the next SHCC meeting by Ms. Connors. Luther Kinney has resigned from the Commission effective December 31, 2011. Peter Carbonneau will take over the Treasurer duties. The Selectmen would like to thank Luther Kinney for his years on the Conservation Commission.

MR. BIELEFIELD made a motion to accept the minutes of November 14, 2011 seconded by MR. STRASSER, the motion was approved unanimously.
