Ms. Bissonneault welcomed to the group.

Mr. Bielefield reported that he had found no sentiment on the part of the SH Museum Trustees to have a memorial on "their" property (which along with the museum building had come from the town cost free!).

Mr. Regan said he'd found a new location for the Memorial at the Meeting House. He had found a site which would easily accept the 8x8' area needed, and distributed a new plan/sketch showing it. It, too, as with those Mr. Regan had previously produced, used the foundation stones from the Meeting House. This was further discussed.

Ms. Bissonneault reported she'd been asked to join the committee by the Improvement Association who was interested in seeing a memorial happen but on a much smaller scale. SHIA felt that a large boulder placed in the circle around the flagpole on the Crapo lawn with a suitable plaque would be desirable, and that they would be willing to contribute toward its creation. Discussion followed.

The committee finally agreed to put both suggestions before the selectmen for their approval.
